International Member care conference - Spain

This is a conference where Missionaries and Mission field leaders/counsellors from all over the world come together. The content is to help/teach on how to deal with social issues they face, for example mission work in a stressful, sometime traumatic environment.

Challenges that arise with third culture children

(Different culture parents working & living in a third culture).

Summerfire - Ireland

A Tented event where Christians can come together from churches all over Ireland to worship, have fellowship and receive teaching.

Transform 2010 - Rome

This is the preparation conference for a mission's outreach in the Mediterranean.

Teenstreet - Germany

This event has in excess of three thousand Teenagers coming together to worship and have fellowship with other teenage Christians from all over Europe

Go Conference - Netherlands

Up to 400 OM Missionaries prepared for their chosen mission field, in an intense two week training conference. These Missionaries go out into all the world as it says in the great commission MARK 16;15

(OM has two Go Conference's each year one in January and this one in September)

It seems to me difficult to explain in detail the importance of the work Pete is involved with, all I know is that there are many lives changed, souls saved, people healed and helped at these various events. Please pray that these events will continue to have an impact on this fallen world.

Paddy has been working together with a few ladies on an outreach project for woman. She has carried this vision for more than two years and the Lord has now opened the doors to go ahead with it. How it all came about clearly showed that the Lord was bringing it all together in his timing.

The concept was to give make-up lessons combined with evangelistic purpose. The course was held over a period of four weeks, one evening per week. The make-up lessons are of a high professional level, but the main focus was the message behind it all. The gospel was split into four main parts to share it as clear as possible.

They are now focusing on ways to get more Women's Ministry going with in the fellowship in Carlisle. The heart is to share the love of Christ with the lost and broken hearted. Only a few weeks ago the Lord has opened more doors for Paddy which will allow her to work with vulnerable women within the community. There are many more ideas on how to expand this ministry, and it has been a great encouragement to see how the local churches have supported it so far. It is so exciting and very humbling that the Lord is using us to serve him in this way. Paddy is grateful to all those who are standing with her in this and support her in payer.



Sophia was two in June and she is doing very well, she loves all the Toddler groups Paddy and her are going to and has just started nursery for half a day on a Monday. Sophia enjoys it and it's a great break for Paddy. It doesn't look like we will get a holiday this year, but Paddy & Sophia were able to travel to two conferences I was working at. One was Summer Fire in Ireland, and the other Teenstreet in Germany.

We are thankful for the nice weather we had early this summer we were able to host a few BBQ and DVD evenings for the Omni team and enjoy getting together outside of the work environment. The team has grown over the last two years and is over twenty people now.

Life in Carlisle is good but can be challenging at times, our main worry right now is that our financial support is a little low and we are praying that more people would partner with us in our calling. In order for us not to be under supported we need to raise around £350 per month, this would bring us back up to the required amount OM sets for serving here in the U.K.
